PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Kemp announced the purpose of tonight's meeting is to consider the reallocation of funding for the Yeadon Youth Employment Program. The reason for the urgency is the start date of this program is July 11. President Kemp reported forty-seven youths interviewed for 10 youth employment positions. Tonight, Council is considering adding ten more youth positions and consequently adding more time for the one seminar teacher. The budget projection is an estimate because the Borough needs to fund employer payroll taxes and handle miscellaneous expenses. There was a brief discussion about the impressive pool of candidates and the need to provide employment services to the teens of the community.

President Kemp requested a motion. President Kemp suggested reallocating funds from the vacant Finance Director position and the vacant Human Resource Manager position.

Motion: Council to approve the reallocation of Year 2011 General Funds as follows: \$3,850 from the Finance Director position, and \$5,350 from the Human Resource Manager position to fund ten additional youths and additional time for the seminar teacher. This brings the additional funding for the Youth Employment Program to \$9,200. The motion recognizes this is an estimate and there may be fluctuations due to payroll taxes and/or miscellaneous items.
