YEAR 2012 BUDGET

There was a continuation of a line by line review of the General Fund expenditures.

President Kemp called for a break at 8 pm. At 8:15 President Kemp reconvened the meeting and called an Executive Session for personnel matters. At 8:40 pm President Kemp called the meeting back to the public session.

President Kemp discussed the changes in PA Act 32 which requires employers to deduct the earned income tax (EIT). Furthermore, the EIT collection will be centralized by County. Mr. Kemp read the letter from Berkheimer advising the Borough of these changes. Berkheimer recommended for FY 2012 EIT the Borough budget in excess of \$ 650,000. Council decided the number needs to be conservative and suggested a bump up.

President Kemp asked if the Borough should continue operating the police substation. Everyone said for now no.

President Kemp called an Executive Session for personnel matters at 9 pm. It was agreed to wrap up the meeting at 10:02 pm.
