Yeadon Participates in National Night Out



Display of Emergency Management Services Tools

Yeadon Borough and the Elm Street Program participated in the 2012 National Night Out hosted by the Lansdowne Police Department and SEPTA Transit Police Department. The event was held on Tuesday August 7th in Lansdowne's Municipal Parking lot.

Rufus Stokes, Mary Nixon, Sharon Wright and Charlie Tasco of Yeadon's Department of Emergency Management Services brought Yeadon's state of the art Emergency Response vehicle to the event.

The vehicle is the brainchild of the late Bill Neill, Yeadon Emergency Management Services director from 1992-2011, who acquired an ambulance in 2009. With the assistance of then Mayor Jacqueline Mosley, Borough Manager Pete Brusco, and the Yeadon Borough Council the vehicle was retrofitted into a mobile office. The vehicle is prepared to respond to any emergency residents may encounter, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. In addition to emergency medical equipment and supplies the vehicle has wifi internet connection allowing the EMS staff to assist residents in completing applications for Red Cross and other emergency service providers.
