- The Civil Service Commission conducted the physical agility test last month, hoping to fill the full time officer position.
- Notified residents that Miles Fields have moved away from the Borough and is seeking a replacement to maintain the Next Door Yeadon website.

- Council President thanked residents who attended the last Caucus meeting,
 which featured a different format. Real-time discussion with department heads
 lead to concerns and comments being addressed during the meeting. Councilors
 sat in the audience in order to really connect with the residents. This format will

- Council President credited the Possenti Firm with the extraordinary financial
 management of the Borough, including four years of no tax increase while adding
 services to the Borough, replacing sanitary sewers, purchasing vehicles, and
 adding to the surplus.
