Dear Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for September 1- 30, 2018.

General Information. Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety. This report contains information obtained from the Department's Alert2 Information Records System, as well as personal insight related to daily operations of the Police Department. This information can help one to better understand what goes on in the Borough, and the work of the personnel in the Department, which includes police, parking enforcement, clerical staff, and school crossing guards.

Crime Prevention.

#MissionLockItUp continues to generate interest and participation in the Borough and nearby jurisdictions. Weatherproof reflective stickers are being produced for use on cars, etc. to help get the message out and remind residents.



- Scam awareness and prevention. Spoke at the Mayor's Forum and at Friendship Circle about the various scams and activities of individuals and organized criminal entities that entice and misrepresent themselves to unwitting victims.
- Video Surveillance Camera Registration. Rolling out in October will be an effort to note residences within the Borough who possess video surveillance systems. Additionally, residents will have the ability to sign up with the Police Department to voluntarily assist with investigations in which their cameras may pick up video relevant to an investigation. No officer will enter a home to seize video or equipment. The program is voluntary and a positive joint effort to put video captured to lawful use in investigations, and let's faces it, that's why we get cameras at home anyway!

Safety Tip – Domestic Violence. While this is the September Report, October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month, and with that in mind, know the warning signs and if you are a victim, or an abuser, seek help before something tragic happens.

- 1. Your partner bullies, threatens, or controls you
- 2. Accuses you of having an affair, and will blame you for abuse, criticizes you
- 3. Tells you what to wear and how you should look
- 4. Threatens to kill you or someone close to you, throws things or punches walls when angry
- 5. Yells at you and makes you feel small

- 6. Your partner controls your money: Keeps cash and credit cards from you
- 7. Puts you on an allowance and makes you explain every dollar you spend
- 8. Keeps you from working whatever job you want
- 9. Your partner cuts you off from family and friends,
- 10. Keeps close tabs on where you go and whom you go with
- 11. Demands or makes you ask for an OK to see friends and family
- 12. Embarrasses you in front of others, and it makes you want to avoid people
- 13. Your partner physically abuses you, and may abandon you in a place you don't know
- 14. Attacks you with weapons, keeps you from eating, sleeping, or getting medical care
- 15. Locks you in or out of your house, punches, pushes, kicks, bites, pulls your hair
- 16. Your partner sexually abuses you: Forces you to have sex, makes you dress in a sexual way
- 17. Makes you feel like you owe them sex, tries to give you an STD, or won't use birth control

 - i. A Juvenile Petition is an arrest of a juvenile offender that results in a Criminal Record being generated. A Petition is for a felony or misdemeanor offense, which the juvenile has been charged with, and the District Attorney has reviewed and approved related charges.

Traffic Citations issued: 170

Based on a review of the areas that present repeated problems, complaints from the public, or officers and/or my observations, directed traffic patrols will be continued for resident, pedestrian, and motorists safety. Major violations continue to revolve around stop sign violations and speed.

Non-Traffic Citations issued: 21

The most common offense for the month was disorderly conduct and harassment.

Police Department Activity.

- 1. Presentation at the Mayor's Forum and attendance at the Public Safety meeting.
- 2. Football season continues and officers provide safety while PWHS Patriots play under the Friday night lights.
 - a. There have been some fights after the games prompting extra police and patrols.
 - b. The school district pays for these extra officers at the games.
 - c. I have been in contact
- 3. Three part-time officers have completed the field training program, and are now on patrol by themselves.

- 4. Body Cams area in full use. They have been a complete asset and are well received.
- 5. Identity theft and Scams presented at Mayor's Forum and Friendship Circle.
- 6. The Department continues to participate in regional DUI Roving Patrols. (OT costs for all officers involved and those working the street to supplement our involvement are reimbursed by a grant).
- 7. Youth Police Academy has started. Nine (9) students in grades 9-10-11 are participating.
- 8. Deer management initiatives are underway; I am frequently fielding concerns about deer in the Borough. The plan is to use police officers with archery only skills to help alleviate overpopulation. Several residents have joined the program.
- 9. Officers continue patrols of the schools.
- 10. Grant paid related traffic enforcement details continue in high violation incident areas.
- 11. Signs promoting support of police and the #MissionLockItUp campaign are being developed.

Police Training.

- 1. Mandatory In-Service Training, as well as other training continues which includes:
 - a. Firearms and Rifle requalifications.
 - b. First Aid/CPR.
 - c. Body Cam Discussions.
 - d. Speed device re-certs.
 - e. DUI Checkpoint Re-certs.
 - f. SWAT training (Firearms, Entry Tactics, etc.)
 - g. Investigative Training for Patrol Officers
 - i. I am putting together Critical Response Teams made up of Yeadon Officers.
 - ii. They will receive additional crime scene, interview/interrogation, and other training to have more of a hands-on approach to major incidents in Yeadon.
 - h. Interview and Interrogation software is in use.
 - i. Racial Intelligence RITE Training.
 - i. Domestic Violence and Mental Health Training for Police Officers.
 - k. Active Shooter/Killer.
 - i. I had three Officers qualify as instructors for this training.

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none.

Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations

- 1. Interviews for Part-Time Police Officer positions are currently on hold as I have achieved a full complement of part-time officers.
- 2. Discussions with the Public Safety Committee on promotional and police officer testing changes to the Civil Service Rules continue.
