Yeadon Police is hosting its 1st Citizen's Police Academy February 27, 2019.

The program will run for 9 weeks, and is being offered to residents of Yeadon. However, applications from neighboring towns' residents will be considered on an available seating basis. Applications must be submitted by Monday, February 18, 2019 for consideration, and will be available online or at Yeadon Police HQ. Once registered, you will be notified of your approval for the course, a week prior to the class start date. Application is attached to this flyer.

Class is limited to 20.

Yeadon Police proudly announces its 1st Annual Citizen's Police Academy. The program will run (9) weeks, beginning February 27, 2019 ending with a graduation on April 18, 2019. Classes will be held at Yeadon Borough Hall, every Wednesday from 6:30pm to 8:30pm unless otherwise noted in the attached schedule. The academy is free, and class size is limited to 20 residents of Yeadon. Area residents' applications will be considered based on available seating.

The Yeadon Citizen's Police Academy will create a challenging atmosphere, and provide residents/cadets with an inside look at what it takes to be a police officer. This program will create confidence, self-discipline, physical security and fitness awareness, and foster team-building mindsets, while bringing you into the world of policing. Instructors are police officers with a strong desire to open lines of communication with those we swear to protect and serve, to create positive police and public interactions, so that a deeper understanding of policing can serve to foster a stronger bond with citizens and their police officers.

Applicant Requirements:

1. The Academy is open to all residents of Yeadon Borough.
2. Applications from outside jurisdictions will be accepted on an available seating basis.
3. Applicants must attend each week's session to receive a certificate at the graduation.
4. Yeadon Police reserves the right through to deny or remove applicants for past or current behaviors that may be detrimental to the program or other residents/cadets taking part in the program.

Attire:

- Casual attire that is not distracting or offensive.

Safety:

- NO weapons or firearms are permitted during the training, even if you possess a valid Permit to Carry a Firearm.

Graduation:

Upon completion of the academy, there will be an official graduation ceremony at the Yeadon Council Meeting. Family members and relatives are invited to attend.

Application Procedure:

Fill out the application completely. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Those accepted into the program will be notified by phone/email one week prior to start of the course.
