Dear Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for February 1-28, 2019.

General Information. Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety. This reflects the work of the personnel in the Department, which includes police, parking enforcement, clerical staff, and school crossing guards.

Crime Prevention.

- **#MissionLockItUp** and the **CSI or 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program** continue to generate interest and participation in the Borough and nearby jurisdictions.
 - Plainclothes patrols are occurring in the Borough.
 - Safety tips and public interaction continues with Nextdoor.
 - Wireless Cameras have been purchased for Mt. Moriah Cemetery.
 - Crime map reporting for community information is being developed.

Safety Tip: ATMS. Thieves are becoming very creative when it comes to trying to steal your credit card information at ATMs and various points of sale devices that require you to insert or swipe your credit card. So here is some useful information to help you avoid becoming a victim.

1. Slow down. Yes slow down and before you just blindly insert or swipe your card look at the device. Does it appear tampered with?
2. Are there glue or tape marks about it?
3. Pull on the device, does something come off?
4. Does the material, color, or numbers appear different than what you usually see?
5. Does the device have a shroud or cover on it that wasn't there the last time you used it?
 - a. Thieves sometimes add their own camera devices to video your keystrokes for pins numbers. These shrouds may have pin-hole cameras.
6. Do you notice someone nearby with a computer or smart device that seems overly interested in watching people at the ATM or gas pump?
7. Does the gas pump seem tampered with?
8. Is there someone working on a pump out of view of the store employees that doesn't appear to be an employee?
9. Thieves are now placing devices inside gas pumps so they are out of view. LOOK at the pump, does it appear tampered with?
10. Is there a car sitting on the lot watching patrons?
11. Take the time to report suspicious behavior.

Traffic Citations issued: 40

Based on a review of the areas that present repeated problems, complaints from the public, or officers and/or my observations, directed traffic patrols will be continued for resident, pedestrian, and motorists safety. Major violations continue to revolve around stop sign violations and speed, especially school zones.

Non-Traffic Citations issued: 6

The most common offense for the month was disorderly conduct.

Police Department Activity.

1. The Adult Citizens Police Academy started Wednesday, February 27, 2019 with 12 participants that included residents of:
 - a. Yeadon, Springfield, and Philadelphia represented.
2. Officers continue patrols of the schools, and YEAA Basketball games.
3. Grant paid related traffic enforcement details continue in high violation incident areas.
4. Yeadon Police Chaplaincy training was completed for 9 Chaplains February 25-26, 2019.
5. Active Shooter/Killer instruction refreshers for Bell was completed, and Cypress and Evans are being planned.
6. A new contest for students is being planned "Chief for a Day". The contest will involve positive acts and interactions with officers.
7. A new contest for adults is also in the works so they too can experience a day in the life as a Chief.
8. A twist on Coffee with a cop, I am planning on having "Candid Conversation with the Chief" on council caucus and meeting nights prior to the meetings taking place. I am usually here between 4 and 7 and thought why not allow the public to come in and meet me and share their concerns or comments.
9. Active Killer (shooter) training is being planned for the Library staff.
10. Attended the Public Safety Meeting.
11. Career Day speaking engagements are slated for March at area schools.

Police Training.

1. Mandatory In-Service Training, as well as other training continues which includes:
 - a. Mandatory In-Service Training required for maintaining status as a Police Officer.

- b. Firearms and Rifle requalifications completed.
- c. First Aid/CPR completed.
- d. SWAT training (Firearms, Entry Tactics, etc.)
2. Advanced Active Shooter/Killer Training
3. Crime Scene Training for Officers is scheduled for April.
4. Inter-County Detective School scheduled for April.
5. Firearms Instructor and Recertification Course scheduled for April.

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none.

Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations

1. Proposal and work on part-time Animal Control Officer is underway.
