Dear Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for April 1-30, 2019.

General Information. Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety. This reflects the work of the personnel in the Department, which includes police, parking enforcement, clerical staff, and school crossing guards.

Crime Prevention.

- #MissionLockItUp and the CSI or 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program continue to generate interest and participation in the Borough and nearby jurisdictions.
 - Plainclothes patrols are occurring in the Borough.
 - Walk-thru of schools and sporting events continues.
 - Safety tips and public interaction continues with Nextdoor.
 - Added patrols during inclement weather, when an upsurge in area vehicle thefts occurs is in effect.
 - Work still in progress to bring crime mapping to Yeadon residents. Negotiating with vendors.

Safety Tip: IRS Scam. Criminals posing as IRS agents make calls to unsuspecting victims telling them that they must call or work with an IRS agent to prevent an arrest because of issues with their taxes. The "agent" requests pertinent personal information and credit card information, and once they hang up they are on spending sprees and opening new accounts with your information. **DON'T FALL FOR THIS.** If there is an issue with your taxes (any issue whatsoever), you will get a letter detailing that issue directly from the Federal, State, or Local Government that will specifically detail what the issue is and how to respond to them. The IRS of any entity (FED, State, Local) does not call you directly, they send a letter to you to create a paper trail of the event for recordkeeping purposes.

If you ever receive such a call, and you are not sure, take a name and number and then call your Police Department to have an officer assist you in determining the validity of such a call or even a letter, as sometimes scam artists will send you a letter saying you won the lottery, etc and need to send money to receive your money. Again, don't fall for this. A simple call to 911 can help you. We are here to help you don't hesitate to call us.

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Traffic Citations issued: 46

Based on a review of the areas that present repeated problems, complaints from the public, or officers and/or my observations, directed traffic patrols will be continued for resident, pedestrian, and motorists safety. Major violations continue to revolve around stop sign violations and speed, especially school zones.

Non-Traffic Citations issued: 5

The most common offense for the month was disorderly conduct.

Police Department Activity.

1. The Adult Citizens Police Academy graduated.
 - a. Graduation certificates were presented at the April 18 Council Meeting.
2. Officers continue patrols of the schools.
3. Grant paid related traffic enforcement details continue in high violation incident areas.
4. **"OPERATION HOUSE-CALL"** is in full swing. Through this program, I alert residents when I am free on patrol, and they can text to have me stop by and meet with them in person to discuss matters or just say hello. Several residents have used this program.
5. Active Killer (shooter) training is planned for the Library staff in May.
6. Attended the Public Safety Meeting at beginning and end of the month of April.
7. Work with the US Marshalls and Drug Task Force continues.
8. The Clergy program students graduated and have been an integral assistance in the recent Tomah death investigation.
9. Two news conferences were held in that Investigation which generated great public support, information, and lead to an arrest of the offender.
10. DUI Checkpoint (grant funded) was scheduled for May 3, 2019.
11. Crime Scene Units solely consisting of Yeadon Police Officers worked the recent Tomah death Investigation, NO CID involvement occurred. This created a complete investigation led by Yeadon Police.
12. Met with Council and the FOP to resolve contractual issues raised by the Yeadon FOP Rep.
13. Met with the Civil Service Commission to update the Civil Service Rules to allow amongst some changes, a wider radius from Yeadon to allow more potential candidates to participate in the selection process.
14. Active Killer (Shooter) presentation being scheduled for Library Employees.
15. Active Killer (Shooter) presentation scheduled for Arthur Gallagher Insurance Company that represents the Borough.

Police Training.

1. Mandatory In-Service Training, as well as other training continues which includes:
 - a. Mandatory In-Service Training required for maintaining status as a Police Officer.
 - a. Firearms and Rifle requalifications continue.
 - b. First Aid/CPR refreshers for officers as needed.
 - c. SWAT training (Firearms, Entry Tactics, etc.)
2. Advanced Active Shooter/Killer Training continues.
3. Crime Scene Training (5) officers graduated April 12, 2019.
4. Inter-County Detective School scheduled now for May 2019 or (5) officers.
5. Firearms Instructor and Recertification Course graduated (2) officers on April 12, 2019
6. Officers attended Autism Training.
7. Officers attended Facial Recognition Program Training.
8. Officers attended Racial Intelligence Training.
9. A Racial Intelligence Executive Leadership Course hosted by Yeadon Police is scheduled for May 21, 2019.

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none.

Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations

1. The need for additional part-time officers continues and plans are in the works to request Council to approve 4 new part time officers by May Council Meeting.
2. Recruitment will begin for area colleges seeking candidates for upcoming police civil service test.
3. Training incentives to begin in-house for officers eligible for promotional examinations.
