Mayor's Forum: The next Mayor's Forum will be held at Yeadon Borough Hall on Tuesday, September 10, 2019. The previous Forum was held on Thursday, June 27, 2019 and was well attended with over thirty residents partaking in a great time of give-and-take as well as many prize winners and a great time of food and refreshments.

Flag Flown at Half-Staff: In keeping with the National and State directive from the President and Governor, on Monday, August, 5, 2019, the Mayor authorized the Borough Flag to be lowered at half-staff to honor those who lost their lives in the Dayton OH and El Paso, TX massacres. This solemn acknowledgement will be observed throughout the week.

Nile Swim Club: We continue to work out arrangements for the Nile with respect to neighbor's complaints on the noise ordinance. The Police Chief is meeting with the management team to iron out specifics of the ordinance.

Citizen's Bank Closure: The Mayor contacted an executive from Citizen's Bank last week to obtain the reason for the bank closing. The Mayor was informed that the bank is closing solely due to the lack of business. Business at the Yeadon branch decreased over the years where it is no longer profitable for Citizens Bank to keep it open.

Richard Ashby Day in Yeadon: On Friday, July 19, the Mayor issued a Proclamation for Library Director Richard Ashby, declaring Friday, July 19, 2019 as "Richard Ashby Day" in Yeadon Borough.
