Dear Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for July 01-31, 2019.

General Information. Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety. This reflects the work of the personnel in the Department, which includes police, parking enforcement, clerical staff, and school crossing guards.

Crime Prevention.

- #MissionLockItUp, 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program, and #Operation House-Call continue to generate interest and participation in the Borough.
 - Plainclothes patrols continue in the Borough.
 - Vacant Property Checks continue for residents going away.
 - Safety tips and public interaction continues with Nextdoor.
 - Teamed with RING, to generate more public interaction and program allows me to publish crime reports via a map (crime mapping) for FREE. Most programs I was reviewing were \$3-6000/year.

Safety Tip: RING PROGRAM / CRIME MAPPING. Are you ready for this! Yeadon Police have teamed with RING. Coming in the next 2 weeks, I will be posting in real time daily information via the RING Neighbors App that includes locations (no physical address, so your home address won't be disclosed) of criminal activity to provide the community with a greater ability to know what's going on in their neighborhood, and assist police in obtaining video and potential information in ongoing investigations to prevent and deter crime. Another great part of this RING Neighbors Program is not only is it free, but you don't have to own a RING system to use it!

The first step to get involved is downloading the RING Neighbors App on your computer, smartphone, or other capable device. Soon, I will be posting on NEXTDOOR, Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram the Yeadon Link for the Neighbors App, but if you want to see how it works beforehand here is a link: <https://shop.ring.com/pages/neighbors>.

I have been trying for some time now to bring to you a crime mapping program. The average costs associated with this is between \$3000-\$6000 dollars a year, and RING gives me the ability to do this for our community for FREE. So don't wait, when you see the Yeadon Link posted get the Yeadon RING Neighbors App, and sign up and get the information you need to stay aware, focused, and informed about what's going on in Yeadon! Partner with me to help deter and combat crime. Together we can create an environment where criminals realize Yeadon is not a place they will succeed.

Traffic Citations issued: 102

Based on a review of the areas that present repeated problems, complaints from the public, or officers and/or my observations, directed traffic patrols will be continued for resident, pedestrian, and motorists safety. Major violations continue to revolve around stop sign violations and speed, especially school zones. A large portion of traffic activity is grant funded, with in-kind enforcement during regular patrols to support the efforts. Additionally, Yeadon Police have been recognized as the leader in DELCO for State traffic enforcement, and I am proud of the efforts of the officers that helped earn this distinction.

Non-Traffic Citations issued: 5

The most common offense for the month was disorderly conduct.

Police Department Activity.

1. Sgt. Shawn Burns will be charge of the Police Department during my vacation August.
2. Plainclothes detail was successful in stopping a Robbery/Theft crime spree affecting us and Lansdowne, with 10 arrests for offenses related to Robbery, Theft, and Firearms Violations.
3. Yeadon and Darby Officers received Awards at the Council Meeting for Bravery and Merit.
4. A resident received an Award for Actions that assisted Police.
5. Grant paid related traffic enforcement details continue in high violation incident areas.
6. ***"OPERATION HOUSE-CALL"*** continues, as well as other initiated programs for residents.
7. Work with the US Marshalls and Drug Task Force continues.
 - a. Drug Forfeitures and Task Force reimbursements help alleviate police department costs for equipment, OT, and public safety endeavors.
8. The Clergy program continues to make Yeadon shine.
9. General Orders related to operational aspects of the department are ongoing, and documented.
10. Policy development and writing continues, policies currently being reviewed, updated, or created include: Computer Usage, Social Media Use, Outside Employment
11. Officers attended Inter-County Crime Information Sharing Meetings.
12. Yeadon is ready for National Night Out Tuesday, August 6, 2019 6-8pm at Bell School
13. Teamed with RING, Fitz Hospital, Friendship Circle, Lidl and WPSD.

14. **National Day of Reconciliation.** Since my arrival here, I have wanted to change the perception of police in a positive manner, and with that said in an effort to continue that endeavor, I have teamed up with a Film Producer from California, and on September 17, 2019 Yeadon will be hosting and participating in a National Event aimed at creating new relationships with Police and Communities. A film will be shown here at Yeadon Borough Hall, with Darby Police Chief Robert Smythe, and other local Police Chiefs joining with me and our communities to open up the lines of communication and thinking to promote and encourage healing the distrust between Police and Communities of Color. The film is called "Walking While Black, L.O.V.E. Is the Answer". I am also working with the producer in securing members of the NFL and other potential celebrities to speak and participate in this 1st National Day of Reconciliation, Tuesday, September 17, 2019. The film will be followed by a Facebook Live discussion that includes cities and communities across the Nation. Watch Nextdoor, Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram for more details, and the ability to get a ticket to this free event which will be listed on Eventbrite.

Police Training.

1. Mandatory In-Service Training, as well as other training continues which includes:
 - a. Mandatory In-Service Training required for maintaining status as a Police Officer.
 - a. Firearms, Rifle requalifications, and First Aid/CPR training continues for officers.
 - b. SWAT training (Firearms, Entry Tactics, etc.)
2. Officers received ongoing legal updates as they affect policing, which include search and seizure, evidence collection, interrogations, juvenile arrests/detentions, and pursuit issues.
3. ERT SWAT Team has paid for training for SWAT officers – Advanced Firearms Training, and Breaching Schools. As you can see we have benefited greatly by our relationship and participation with the Regions SWAT Team, a vital asset to policing and the community, while also saving costs associated with training of officers.

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none. Furthermore, a failure to train can result in a Federal Lawsuit award, should a plaintiff show the Department failed to provide training to officers to keep them aware of and in line with current practices and police service protocols.

Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations

1. Interviews being conducted for:
 - a. Part Time Police
 - i. Council will be requested to authorize (4) conditional offers of employment to individuals currently being evaluated for part time police positions.
 - ii. Conditional Offers allow us to continue the process of evaluation which includes; physical, psychological, and drug screens.
 - b. Crossing Guards
2. Work continues on Civil Services matters for hiring of full time Police Officers. Hoping to post a test by end of August or early September, and with the process to prepare a final list, looking for potential new patrol officers, and promotions to occur in January to avoid any budget issues this year.
