Dear Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for August 01-31, 2019.

**General Information.** Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety. This reflects the work of the personnel in the Department, which includes police, parking enforcement, clerical staff, and school crossing guards.

## Crime Prevention.

- #MissionLockItUp, 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program, and #Operation House-Call continue to generate interest and participation in the Borough.
- Plainclothes patrols continue in the Borough.
- Vacant Property Checks continue for residents going away.
- Safety tips and public interaction continues with Nextdoor.
- RING training took place with 4 officers and I, and will be up and running in September 2019.

**Safety Tip:** With the fall weather coming and the temperatures getting nicer, we sometimes have a tendency to leave windows open for the fresh air. That's all good while you're home, but don't forget to close them if you are going to be outside for extended periods of time and the open windows are not in your view, or you are leaving to run an errand. Thieves rely on these opportunities to break in your home. This includes locking the rear door if you're out front and vice versa if you're out back of your home. If someone walking by is looking for an easy burglary they may check the other door while you're distracted and quickly enter and search for something to easily take. Be vigilant. Be aware of your surroundings, and don't let complacency and routine make you a target for crime.

**Traffic Citations issued: 94**

Based on a review of the areas that present repeated problems, complaints from the public, or officers and/or my observations, directed traffic patrols will be continued for resident, pedestrian, and motorists safety. Major violations continue to revolve around stop sign violations and speed, especially school zones. A large portion of traffic activity is grant funded, with in-kind enforcement during regular patrols to support the efforts. Additionally, Yeadon Police have been recognized as the leader in DELCO for State traffic enforcement, and I am proud of the efforts of the officers that helped earn this distinction.

The most common offense for the month was disorderly conduct.

**Police Department Activity.**

1. Sgt. Shawn Burns was in charge of the Police Department during my vacation August.
2. Grant paid related traffic enforcement details continue in high violation incident areas.
3. **"OPERATION HOUSE-CALL"** continues, as well as other initiated programs for residents.
4. Work with the US Marshalls and Drug Task Force continues.
  - a. Drug Forfeitures and Task Force reimbursements help alleviate police department costs for equipment, OT, and public safety endeavors.
5. The Clergy program continues to make Yeadon shine.
6. General Orders related to operational aspects of the department are ongoing, and documented.
7. Policy development and writing continues with policies currently being reviewed, updated, and/or created which include: Sick Leave, Acting-In-Rank, and Part Time Police Officers.
8. Officers attended Inter-County Crime Information Sharing Meetings.
9. Yeadon participated in the National Night Out Tuesday, August 6, 2019 at Bell School.
10. **National Day of Reconciliation.** On September 17, 2019 Yeadon will be hosting and participating in a National Event aimed at creating new relationships with Police and Communities. A film will be shown here at Yeadon Borough Hall, with Darby Police Chief Robert Smythe, and other local Police Chiefs joining with me and our communities to open up the lines of communication and thinking to promote and encourage healing the distrust between Police and Communities of Color. The film is called "Walking While Black, L.O.V.E. Is the Answer". The film will be followed by a Facebook Live discussion that includes cities and communities across the Nation. Watch Nextdoor, Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram for more details, and the ability to get a ticket to this free event which will be listed on Eventbrite.
11. Various intersections are being repainted to designate stop locations, and provide some visual calming devices for motorists in an effort to reduce speed and traffic violations.
12. Signage in various locations has been updated to reduce driver confusion at problem locations.
13. New Uniform and equipment vendor has been secured reducing costs.
14. Brandywine Animal Control basically walked away from the Borough because we would not sign a contract that they would not negotiate terms on.
  - a. Officers have been handling dog and animal complaints finding owners of lost dogs, and working with residents to find shelters who will accept the animals.
  - b. Delco Animal Control has also been helping and their fees are reasonable.

- c. Substantial savings because we are not being forced to pay exorbitant prices for a vendor who would not negotiate terms of the deal.
- d. The County may also be getting ready to open a new Delco Shelter.
- e. I have two traps that I help neighbors out with to remove groundhogs, etc.

---

**Police Training.**

- 1. Mandatory In-Service Training, as well as other training continues which includes:
  - a. Mandatory In-Service Training required for maintaining status as a Police Officer.
  - a. Firearms, Rifle requalifications, and First Aid/CPR training continues for officers.
  - b. SWAT training (Firearms, Entry Tactics, Woodland Tactics, etc.)

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none. Furthermore, a failure to train can result in a Federal Lawsuit award, should a plaintiff show the Department failed to provide training to officers to keep them aware of and in line with current practices and police service protocols.

**Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations**

- 1. Part Time Police Officers will be ceremoniously sworn in during the September 19, 2019 Council Meeting. Three (3) new part-time police officers were sworn in by Mayor Hepkins on Thursday, August 29, 2019 to begin the FTO program that runs 8 weeks.
- 2. The officers signed a new part-time contract requiring them to reimburse the Department for any expenses related to their hiring should they fail to complete the FTO program or leave prior to a minimum 18 months of employment with Yeadon Borough.
- 3. I have met with William Davis with the Police Academy, who has agreed to conduct the testing for new police officers and promotions needed to bring the Department to full strength.
- 4. I am looking to post the test on September 23, 2019 and have the testing conducted November 16, 2019, to complete the process prior to January 2020, so with the new budget promotions and hiring's can be approved.
