Dear Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for September 01-30, 2019.

General Information. Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety. This reflects the work of the personnel in the Department, which includes police, parking enforcement, clerical staff, and school crossing guards.

Crime Prevention.

- #MissionLockItUp, 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program, and #Operation House-Call continue to generate interest and participation in the Borough.
- Plainclothes patrols continue in the Borough.
- Safety tips and public interaction continues with Nextdoor.
- RING training has been completed, and more interaction and use is in the works
 - Ring will help build a monthly crime map for residents and police use.

Safety Tip: Deer Season is upon us, and I ask that residents be vigilant for persons that may be trying to hunt on properties without written permission from this Department. That authorization comes through the Police Department, which has teamed with the Pa Game Commission and the Fairmount Parks Association of Philadelphia. No firearms of any kind may be used, and persons authorized to hunt must be vetted and approved by this Writer. There has been someone soliciting in Yeadon purporting to be with this program and he is not. Should someone come to your door other than an officer in uniform or myself asking about this program, call 911 to report the suspicious person. Be safe out there.

 - i. A Juvenile Petition is an arrest of a juvenile offender that results in a Criminal Record being generated. A Petition is for a felony or misdemeanor offense,

which the juvenile has been charged with, and the District Attorney has reviewed and approved related charges.

Traffic Citations issued: 97

Based on a review of the areas that present repeated problems, complaints from the public, or officers and/or my observations, directed traffic patrols will be continued for resident, pedestrian, and motorists safety. Major violations continue to revolve around stop sign violations and speed, especially school zones. A large portion of traffic activity is grant funded, with in-kind enforcement during regular patrols to support the efforts. Additionally, Yeadon Police have been recognized as the leader in DELCO for State traffic enforcement, and I am proud of the efforts of the officers that helped earn this distinction.

Non-Traffic Citations issued: 12

The most common offense for the month was disorderly conduct.

Police Department Activity.

1. Grant paid related traffic enforcement details continue in high violation incident areas.
2. **“OPERATION HOUSE-CALL”** continues, as well as other initiated programs for residents.
3. Work with the US Marshalls and Drug Task Force continues.
 - a. Drug Forfeitures and Task Force reimbursements help alleviate police department costs for equipment, OT, and public safety endeavors.
4. The Clergy program continues to make Yeadon shine and they were recognized at the Mayor’s Forum.
5. General Orders related to operational aspects of the department are ongoing, and documented.
6. Policy development and writing continues with policies currently being reviewed, updated, and/or created which include: Use of Force, Report Dissemination, Computer Usage and Confidentiality.
7. Officers attended Inter-County Crime Information Sharing Meetings.
8. **National Day of Reconciliation.** On September 17, 2019 Yeadon hosted and participated in a National Event aimed at creating new relationships with Police and Communities. The film called “Walking While Black, L.O.V.E. Is the Answer” was shown to an estimated 60 people. Fox29 Joyce Evans covered the story here, and the film was followed by a Facebook Live discussion that includes cities and communities across the Nation. The event generated great discussion, and a request for it again.
 - a. Plans are being made to show the film again and invite High School students and the public in February.
 - b. Residents from Bucks County came to be part of this because other jurisdictions would not get involved. Speaks volumes for Yeadon!
9. Various intersections are being repainted to designate stop locations, and provide some visual calming devices for motorists in an effort to reduce speed and traffic violations.
10. Signage in various locations has been updated to reduce driver confusion at problem locations.
11. Civil Service Rule changes were made, and after a meeting with the Civil Service Commission, the test has been announced for November 16, 2019 for both promotions and entry level police officers.
12. Police investigated a robbery in which the victim fatally shot one of the suspects who was armed with a handgun. Various posts made on Nextdoor to keep the public informed.
13. The Yeadon Youth Academy has been postponed due to various investigations taking too much of my time at the moment.

Police Training.

1. Mandatory In-Service Training, as well as other training continues which includes:
 - a. Mandatory In-Service Training required for maintaining status as a Police Officer.
 - a. Firearms, Rifle requalifications, and First Aid/CPR training continues for officers.
 - b. SWAT training (Firearms, Entry Tactics, Woodland Tactics, etc.)

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none. Furthermore, a failure to train can result in a Federal Lawsuit award, should a plaintiff show the Department failed to provide training to officers to keep them aware of and in line with current practices and police service protocols.

Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations

1. Part Time Police Officers were ceremoniously sworn in during the September 19, 2019 Council Meeting.
2. The officers signed a new part-time contract requiring them to reimburse the Department for any expenses related to their hiring should they fail to complete the FTO program or leave prior to a minimum 18 months of employment with Yeadon Borough.
3. Applications are out on the website, and various social media outlets, and the Solicitor is posting in local newspapers.
