Mayor's Citizen's Forum: On Tuesday, December 17, the Mayor held the fourth and final 2019 quarterly Citizen's Forum at Borough Hall. Approx. 40 residents attended. An interactive Q & A focused on Crime, Traffic & Speeding and deer control initiative. It was a very festive atmosphere with 10 holiday gift card giveaways courtesy of the Mayor. Mayor's Veteran's Day Luncheon & Mary Gay Scanlon: The Mayor and the Recreation Committee honored our local veterans at our 5th annual Veteran's Day Luncheon on Saturday, November 9, 2019 at Borough Hall. In attendance to join us was our new Congresswoman from the 5th Congressional District Mary Gay Scanlon, appointed vice-chair of the House Judiciary committee over the Impeachment hearings by Nancy Pelosi.

Census Task Force: The Mayor has commissioned a taskforce to assist the Mayor's Office to do all that we can as a community to ensure that every Yeadonite is registered for the 2020 Census. More information will be forthcoming.

Road Construction: Island Road will be blocked between 70th Street and Main Street in Darby for roadwork for the next several weeks. Residents navigating that thoroughfare are urged to bypass that area using back roads for easier passage.
