Yeadon Police Monthly Report: January 2020

February 4, 2020

Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for the month of January 2020.

General Information. Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety.

Crime Prevention:

- The Department is utilizing a ***BAIT CAR*** to deter thefts and stolen vehicles. 5 arrests have resulted in its use in 3 days.
 - ***#MissionLockItUp, 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program, and #Operation House-Call*** continue.
 - **STOP Program** (S-Stop, T-Theft, O-Of, P-Property) is in development. Designed similar to the Philadelphia Police SAVE Program, this program is an effort to deter vehicle and other property theft. A identifying sticker is being created which once available to the public will be a voluntary program in which a resident applies the sticker to a vehicle or property, in which the owner has provided their consent to have the vehicle or person carrying the property to be stopped to identify the person in control of the property is actually authorized to possess it. I have reached out to the Delaware County Chiefs Association in that this program cannot work if other departments don't understand the program or its identifying mark. The program does not authorize a search or other intrusion of the vehicle operator or possessor unless the investigatory stop points to a possible theft detected by the officer. The owner would provide a good contact number which could be used to confirm the possessor unless it is actually the owner themselves.

Safety Tip: IRS Scams. Remember the IRS will not call you and demand payment over the phone. You if audited or owe for example, a letter will always be sent to you. The letter may include a number to call to speak with an IRS representative but all transactions with the IRS usually occur through their website or via a check sent to an IRS mail drop pursuant to standard income tax reporting and procedures. Don't get scammed. Not sure? Call us and have an officer stop by to take a look at any letter and make sure it is authentic. Any entity that asks you to pay fees or fines with gift cards is a scam, hang up and call 911 to make a report, especially if you have already provided any personal information that can jeopardize your identity.

4. Ofc. Rodney Irby has retired and will be recognized at the Mayor's Forum as well.

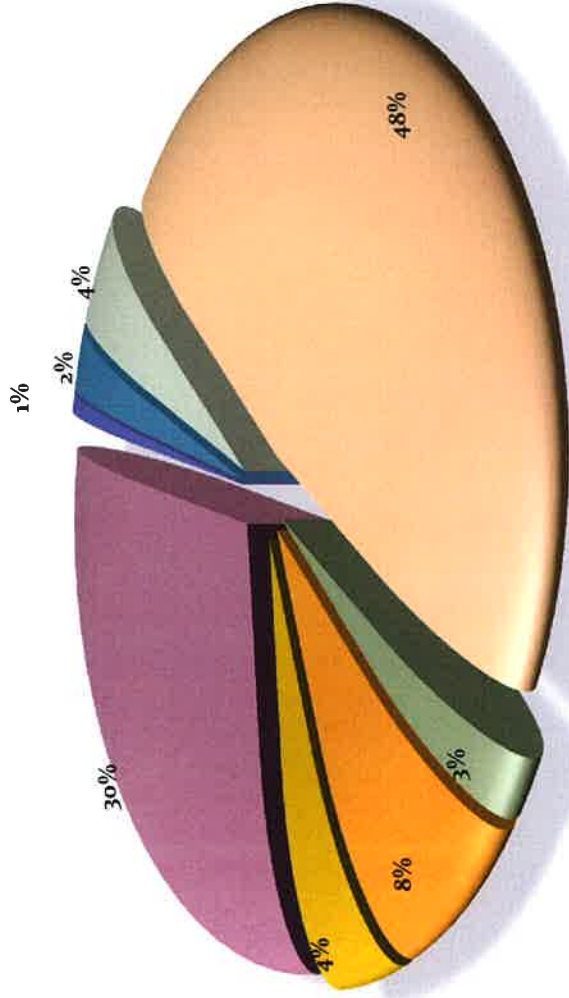

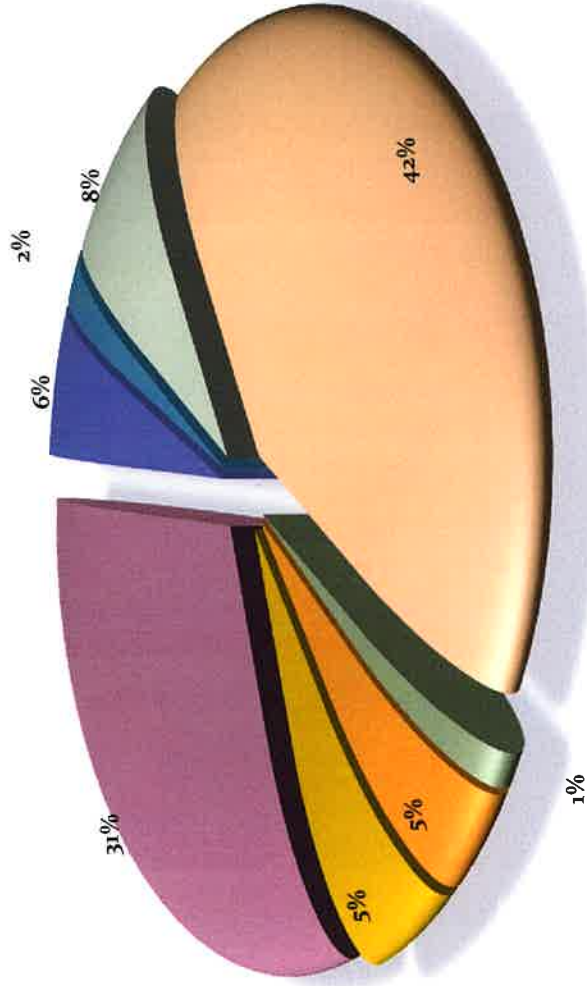

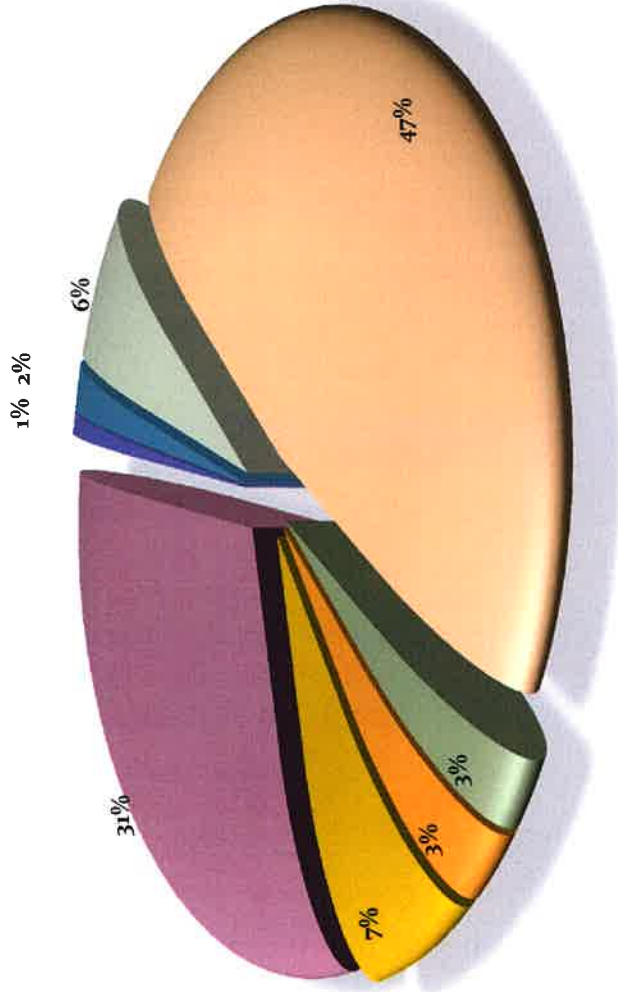
