**Yeadon Police Monthly Report: February 2020**

**March 9, 2020**

---

Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the members of the Yeadon Police Department for the month of February 2020.

**General Information.** Information is a vital part of being able to provide answers to residents that can help others understand the dynamics of law enforcement, activities that occur daily to make a community safe, as well as associated costs dynamic to public safety.

---

**Crime Prevention:**

- The Department is utilizing a **BAIT CAR** to deter thefts and stolen vehicles. 5 arrests have resulted in its use in 3 days.
- **#MissionLockItUp, 'Cam Saw It' Camera Program, and #Operation House-Call** continue.
- **STOP Program** (S-Stop, T-Theft, O-Of, P-Property) is in development. Several other Delaware County Police Agencies want to participate for their communities. A poll was conducted recently on Nextdoor with 24 votes received. 46% need more information, 42% liked the program idea, and 12% stated they would not participate. Work is still being conducted including a review of the name of the program.

**Safety Tip:** Covid-19 is creating widespread anxiety, and it is important to practice safe hygiene and if you are sick - STAY HOME and out of the public even if it's just the common cold. Viruses are spread when we fail to maintain common everyday practices that can help eliminate exposures and spreading of various viruses and bacteria. Carry tissue with you and USE it to shield a cough or sneeze. Wash your hands frequently and don't touch your face or food without having washed well. Until this is under control avoid shaking hands and other close contact with people outside your home. If you get sick monitor for:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

Remember the incubation period may be 2-14 days after exposure, but this can change as the virus changes. Seek medical attention if you experience these symptoms but don't panic. I understand that this may be easier said than done, but remember you must be exposed to someone who has been to an effected part of the world or country, and/or exposed to the virus through close personal contact or someone coughing or sneezing near you. Also remember to check on the elderly who may become

more reclusive because of the scare that has been created in the media. Call and check on them. If you're sick remember avoid the elderly and small children until this matter is brought to a better understanding for all of us and hopefully a vaccine for the virus is developed.

**Police Department Activity.**

1. General Orders related to police operations continue as needed pursuant to operational needs.
  2. Policy development and writing continues with policies currently being reviewed, updated, and/or created.
    - a. New Police has been enacted – Unbiased Policing.
  3. Police Department continues working with a Federal grant liaison to acquire funding for police related expenses for 2020.
    - a. The process is extensive just to be able to apply to various programs.
  4. Yeadon Police Citizens Police Academy started March 4, with 12 attendees.
  5. Groundbreaking for The LOVE Garden is tentatively on hold. I have contacted the US Dept. of Agriculture and believe I will be securing a Grant to help fund this project. Reps from the USDA will be coming to Yeadon to review the endeavor and are excited about this project unlike any other that have heard of.
  6. Yeadon Police have received an award for Region 1 Aggressive Driving Project.
  7. Ofc. Irby was recognized at the Mayor's Forum.
  8. Attended the monthly Public Safety Meeting.
  9. Yeadon Police Youth Aid Panel is currently handling juvenile cases transferred to this program to avoid court that meet the criteria for inclusion in this program.
    - a. Cases usually involved low level summary offenses.
  10. Yeadon Clergy were given Certs from the Delaware County Chaplains.
  11. The parking amnesty program is working and many individuals are taking advantage of the program.
  12. Drug Forfeitures of over \$5000 have been received last month.

**Police Training.**

1. Mandatory In-Service Training for 2020 has started.
2. Mandatory Firearms Training has started.

3. Supervisors are receiving training in Advanced Leadership Techniques.

Training is a vital aspect of a professional police agency, and ongoing education and training will be afforded officers to promote officer development and a quality of service to the public second to none. Failure to train can result in a Federal Lawsuit a resulting punitive damage awards, should a plaintiff show the Department failed to provide training to officers to keep them aware of and in line with current practices and police service protocols.

**Recruitment, Hiring, Promotional Examinations**

1. Four (4) Promotions, five (5) new full time and three (3) new part time officers were sworn in on March 5, 2020 by the Mayor during the Mayor's Forum dedicated to this endeavor.
  - a. I would like to thank the Mayor, Council President, Council, Councilor McCabe of the Civil Service Commission, Solicitor Charles Gibbs, and the Management Team for helping me make this happen.
