Yeadon Police Monthly Report: July 2020

August 12, 2020

Mayor Hepkins:

It is my pleasure to present to you and Council the Police Department's Monthly Report for the services performed by the Officers and Staff of the Yeadon Police Department for the month of July 2020.

COVID19 Ops:

- Police operations continue with no infections noted within the PD or staff.
- Delaware County is in the green phase and no issues to report.
- Social Distancing complaints have come in related to permits issued for Yeadon Park, and the groups present with a permit have been family oriented, and have heeded advice as to masks and distancing guidelines for the most part.
 - Requesting that permits for park use before being granted are vetted through the PD as was a practice in the past, to ensure groups seeking use of the park are using it for intended requests and not planning activities that result in monetary gain or inappropriate use.
 - This vetting process is also used for block party requests.
 - The process has successfully prevented misuse of permits.

Police Department Activity.

- 1. General Orders related to police operations continue as needed pursuant to operational needs.
- 2. All community activities that involved use of the Borough facilities or meeting in person continue to be on hold. (Citizen's Academy, LOVE Garden).

Monthly Report: July 2020

- 3. Businesses are monitored for compliance with State Orders governing green phase.
- 4. Officers continue to participate in numerous Birthday, Graduation, Anniversary, and party drive-bys at the request of residents or after I offered our involvement. All are well received and appreciated.
- 5. Traffic Enforcement Grants are funding proactive traffic enforcement details for speed, seat belt compliance and other traffic complaint issues in the Borough.

Police Training.

- 1. Daily briefings that include roll call training topics continues.
- 2. Supervisors have been educated through a recent Leadership Mindset class held in Langhorne.
- 3. Training has resumed as the County has progressed into the Green Phase, allowing outdoor and classroom training to resume for Police Officers.
 - a. Note that while training was limited during the initial phases of the pandemic, police training continue within the Department using ZOOM, Roll Call, and online courses to ensure the integrity and standards required to maintain status as a Police Officer in Pa.
- 4. Officers continue to utilize PPE and take temp checks 3 times a tour to help protect us from COVID.
- 5. Mandatory In-Service Training has resumed as operations have entered the green phase.
- 6. Department is preparing to send at least 2 officers to a Use of Force School in an effort to have in house review of force use, and keep officers up to date in all options.

- 5. Plans for 2nd Annual National Day of Reconciliation is underway for September 17, 2020.
