## **Police Department Activity.**

1. General Orders related to police operations continue as needed pursuant to operational needs.
2. Businesses are monitored for compliance with State Orders governing green phase.
3. Officers continue to participate in numerous Birthday, Graduation, Anniversary, and party drive-bys at the request of residents or after I offered our involvement.
4. Traffic Enforcement Grants are funding proactive traffic enforcement details.
5. Officers continue to utilize PPE and take temp checks 3 times a tour to help prevent COVID.
6. Traffic enforcement measures in high incident/complaint areas.

## **Police Training.**

1. Daily briefings that include roll call training topics continues.
2. Mandatory In-Service Training has resumed.
3. Officer Involved Shooting Response training for Supervisors scheduled for Oct 19, 2020.
4. Critical Incidents in the country are discussed and critiqued.

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**Chief of Police Activity.**

1. New public survey is completed. Only 30 individuals responded, I may do another end of year, and set it up to coincide with the newsletter for more exposure. Results are attached, I am very proud of our work and connection to the community. It shows in the results.
2. I continue to participate as a panelist for several Police Reform programs/projects throughout Delaware County and the region:

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**Traffic Issue Concerns Church Lane Corridor.**

This issue is creating a lot of talk on Nextdoor, as well as complaints via online reporting and phone calls. The matter is not going unnoticed, and I wanted to take a moment to address some concerns of residents who are being victimized by errant drivers involved in accidents in the area.

- Speed seems to be a chief complaint. Some activities attempting to curb that:
  - ✓ New signage, cameras, and lighting maintenance
  - ✓ New street markings
    - Parking lane lines reducing visual sight paths
    - Crosswalks at all intersections
    - Studies to change traffic movements on;
      - Guenther
      - Whitby
      - Darnell (if no light)
- Work on having a DUI checkpoint along Church Lane, as majority of the accidents are not speed related, but alcohol related with multiple arrests for DUI along here.
- As a PENNDOT controlled highway, we are limited with some changes without their approval and involvement.
- Work to generate improvements and assist residents will continue.

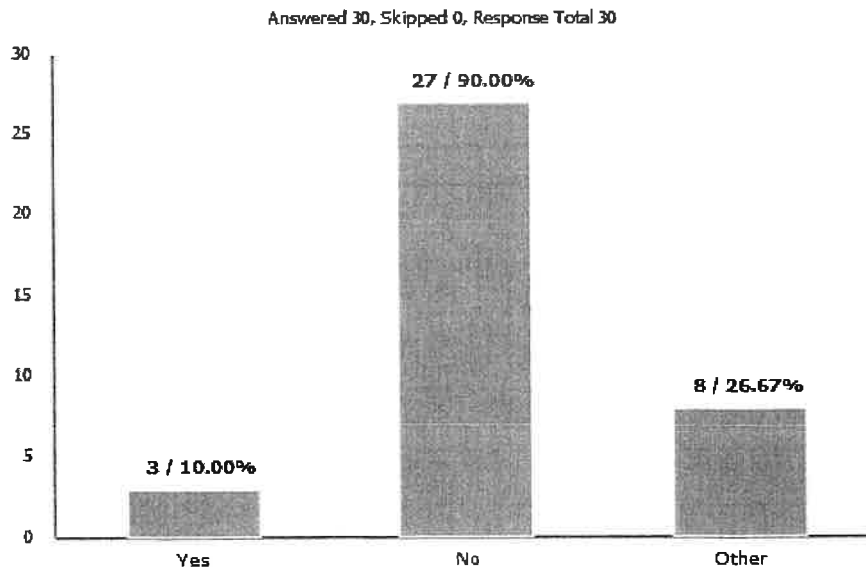

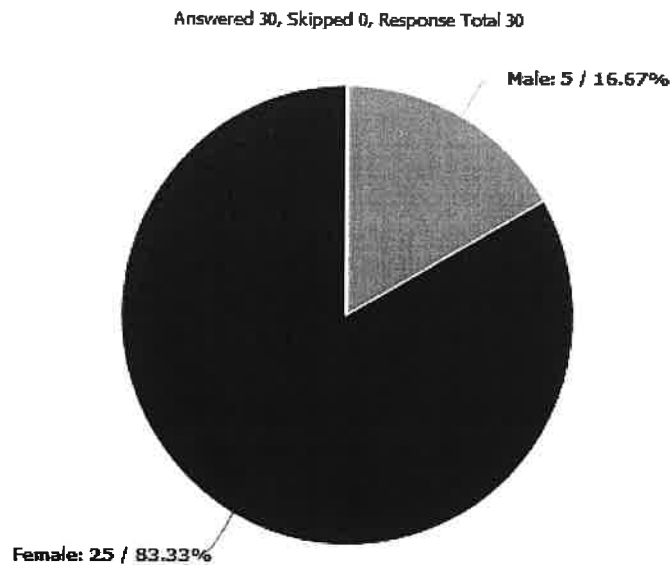

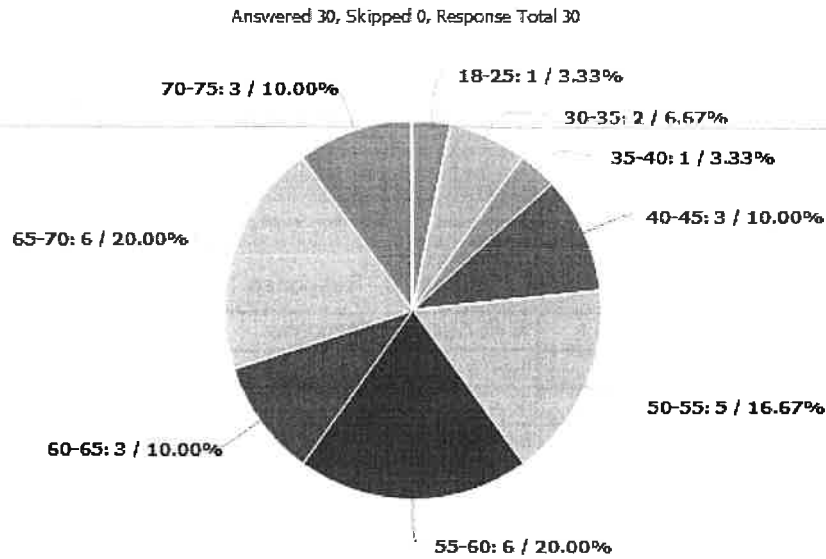
11. What is your sex?

12. What is your age range?

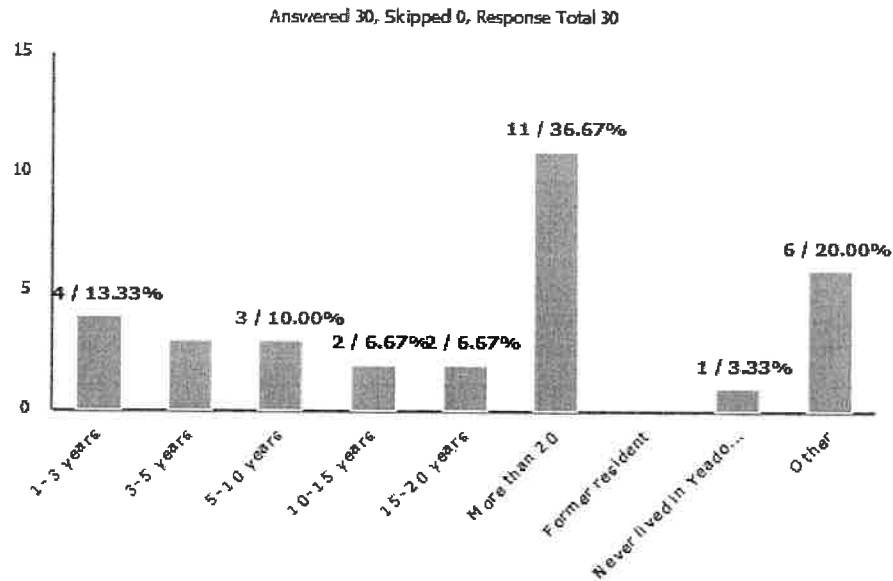

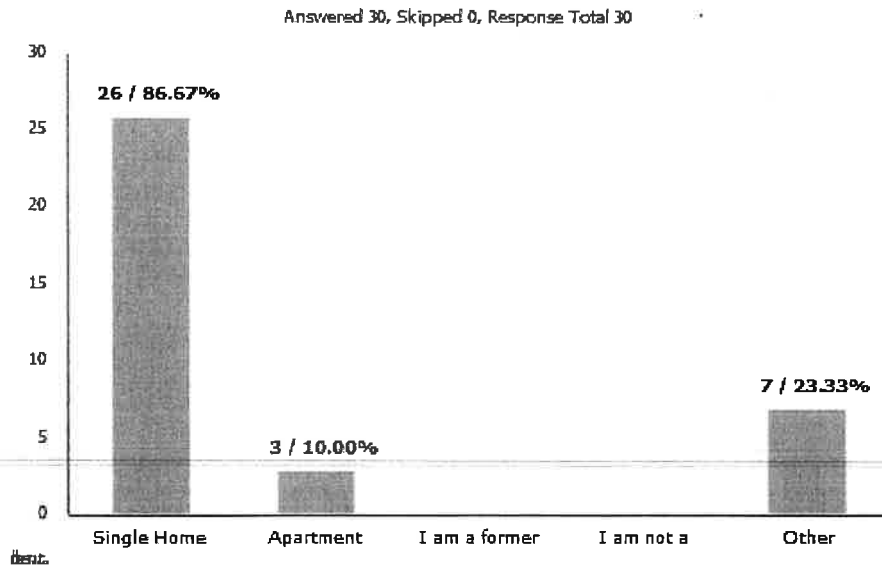
