



Mayor's Report

April 15, 2021

Mayor's Citizen's Forum: On Thursday, March 4, the first quarterly Mayor's Citizens Forum was held via zoom. The next Forum is scheduled for June 3rd. This special Forum focused on our Wellness Center and the COVID Vaccination rollout. Special guests included County Councilor Kevin Madden and County Health Advisor Dr. Lisa O'Mahony. A follow up meeting was established to ensure County Council met our deliverables for Borough Residents.

Yeadon Wellness Center & Vaccines: Delaware County Wellness Center (and soon to be the County Health Center) celebrated its grand opening on January 28, 2021. As a result of the Mayor's Forum Meeting cited above, County Council granted "Special Yeadon Days" for our seniors to get in front of the line with vaccine allocation for Yeadonites.

Currently, we are now in the over age 16 category where all adults are now eligible for the vaccine.

Our Wellness Center has been distributing the Moderna Vaccine – with the Pfizer in some other places. A temporary halt has been placed on the Johnson and Johnson Vaccine as there were some reports that it may have caused blood clots in some subjects. I have been advised that we have not distributed any of the J & J vaccines in Yeadon.

We have petitioned the County to replace the temporary sign at the Yeadon Wellness Center with a more permanent aesthetically pleasing sign. They have promised to do so in short order.

Vaccines can still be obtained by checking our website and calling the County Vaccine Hotline at: 484-276-2100. Homebound non-ambulatory seniors can also schedule the vaccine and a healthcare worker will come out to their home to administer.

Public Safety Meeting: The Public Safety Meeting was held on Saturday, February 27. Next meeting will be held via zoom on Saturday, April 24 at 9:30 am.

Nile Swim Club – Historical Site Marker: The Yeadon Borough Historical Commission (YBHC) was successful in having the iconic Nile Swim Club in Yeadon, Pennsylvania officially recognized as a Historical Pennsylvania landmark. A dedication ceremony will be held at the Nile Swim Club on **Saturday, May 22, tentatively at 10:00 AM**. Check the borough & library websites for latest updates.

The Nile continues to provide boxed food each Saturday for local residents, which has been widely publicized. They have now moved the distribution site from the Nile, to Mercy Fitzgerald Hospital's Parking lot due to the overwhelming response which had created traffic issues around the Nile.
