### Public Works May Report

#### **Emergency Call Out:**

#### **Announcements:**

- All grass cutting equipment has been inspected, upgraded if needed, and ready to operate this spring season new topsoil and seed on borough plots.
- Potholes are filled on a weekly basis and Penn/Dot made a trip down Church Lane and made the necessary repairs.
- New crosswalks, no parking lines and stop bars are almost completed and upgrades.
- Peco Gas Project between McDade and Duncan Ave Bell Ave between McDade and Rundale Ave. there will be road closures periodically for the next several weeks residents have been notified I will be on site every day to make sure things run smoothly.
- Preparation for our Freedom Day celebration on June 20<sup>th</sup> is in the final stages.

#### **Projects:**

- **Analyzing I&I report with Borough Engineer to identify sewer and stormwater improvement projects**
- **Abatements are enforced due to daily communication between the Code Dept and the Public Works Dept.**
- **The new flag is installed on the old cannon site at Chester Ave and West Cobbs Creek Pkwy.**



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### **Highway Maintenance:**

During the months of April and May the Public Works Department completed the following regarding highway maintenance.

- Removed and installed handicap signs with the Chief's approval.
- Potholes are being patched and repaired as they arise. We ask if residents see a pothole, please report it to the Public Works Department at 610-623-3636.
- Storm inlets are being cleared of all trash and debris to ensure the stormwater run-off system is operating as designed.
- All Borough property, sidewalks and parking lots are kept clean on a weekly scheduled basis.
- Monthly routine maintenance and checks were performed on all Borough vehicles.
- Monthly routine inspections on all parking lots were performed around the Borough.
- Monthly vehicle issues were handled as they arose.
- Borough vehicles' state inspections and general maintenance have been completed.
- Trash and litter are picked up on a daily basis.

The Borough has received quotes for addressing Graceland cemetery project goals.

### **PWD Grant Applications**
