Public Works July Report

Emergency Call Out:

The Public Works Department is at 544 West Cobbs Creek Parkway.

Announcements:

- All borough properties are receiving a new layer of mulch.
- Potholes are filled on a weekly basis.
New crosswalks, Don't Block the Box at Church and Baily.
- Peco Gas Project between McDade and Duncan Ave Bell Ave between McDade and Rundale Ave.is at a standstill due to manpower issues. They will start tying in services mid-to-late next week.
- Alan Myers under contract with PennDOT will be performing milling paving in the Borough, Church Lane from McDade Blvd to Baltimore Ave milling will start late August, these dates will be tentative to weather conditions, all work will be performed in the nighttime.
- Twice a week trash pickup started on July 6 and runs through September 4.

Projects

- **Abatements are enforced due to daily communication between the Code Dept and the Public Works Dept.**
- **The new flag at the old cannon was installed then stolen in less than a month, with help from the Yeadon Fire Co. and Public Works we installed a new Flag for the Fourth of July weekend.**



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Highway Maintenance:

During the months of June and July the Public Works Department completed the following regarding highway maintenance.

- Removed and installed handicap signs with the Chief's approval.
- Potholes are being patched and repaired as they arise. We ask if residents see a pothole, please report it to the Public Works Department at 610-623-3636.
- Storm inlets are being maintained and inspected of all trash and debris to ensure the stormwater run-off system is operating as designed.
- All Borough property, sidewalks and parking lots are kept clean on a weekly scheduled basis.
- Monthly routine maintenance and checks were performed on all Borough vehicles.
- Monthly routine inspections on all parking lots were performed around the Borough.
- Monthly vehicle issues were handled as they arose.
- Borough vehicles' state inspections and general maintenance have been completed.
- Trash and litter are picked up on a daily basis.
