Public Safety Meeting

The last two (2) Public Safety (PS) Meetings were held on Saturday, July 25 & on Saturday, August 29 at 9:30 via Zoom. July's meeting had 25 attendees & August's meeting registered 18. Mayor's Citizen's Forum/Public Safety Symposium

A special Public Safety Symposium was held on Tuesday, September 1, 2026 at Borough Hall Auditorium on the 2nd Floor. The topic of discussion was how to cope with neighborly disputes (which have become a point of contention throughout the borough), while providing resources for addressing mental health issues. Special guests included District Attorney Tanner Rouse, Sheriff Kamara Siddiq, District Judge Keith Williams, along with many other mental health organizations who assisted in the symposium.

Police staffing

Our Police Department is currently one (1) full-time officer down due to a retirement last year. A candidate is currently in the process of completing their Physical Agility, Psychological and background checks. After successful completion of this vetting process, the candidate will be presented to Council for hiring.
