Public Works September Report

Emergency Call Out:

The Public Works Department is at 544 West Cobbs Creek Parkway.

Announcements:

- The public works department is always one step ahead, Leaf machine in ready for the upcoming leaf season, all snow equipment is in the maintenance phase.
- Potholes are filled on a weekly basis.
- I'm in the process of having the shade trees evaluated with several arborists, more information to share.
- Following July 11, 2026, storms all streetlight and wiring are completed.
- Road program is under way Penn St. and Whitby ave are being paved.
- Peco Gas Project between MacDade and Duncan Ave and on Bell Ave between MacDade and Rundale Ave. All gas services are completed and cleaned up and in the settlement stage.
- Alan Myers under contract with PennDOT will be performing milling paving in the Borough, Church Lane from MacDade Blvd to Baltimore Ave milling will start mid-September, these dates will be tentative to weather conditions, all work will be performed in the nighttime.
- A pre-construction meeting last week went well, The West Cobbs Creek Pky traffic coming ADA improvement project. When we receive information it
- The Peco Gas project from MacDade Blvd from Wycombe Ave to Union ave will be milled and overlayed, Baily Rd. will be replaced with concert, and Union Ave will be mill and overlay.

Projects

- **Abatements are enforced on weekly communication between the Code Dept. and the Public Works Dept.**
- **Graceland Cemetery is in the prosses of a major cleanup, trimming up trees and locating gray plots, this will be a long and tedious process.**



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Highway Maintenance:

During the months of August and September the Public Works Department completed the following regarding highway maintenance.

- Removed and installed handicap signs with the Chief's approval.
- Potholes are being patched and repaired as they arise. We ask if residents see a pothole, please report it to the Public Works Department at 610-623-3636.
- Storm inlets are being maintained and inspected of all trash and debris to ensure the stormwater run-off system is operating as designed.
- All Borough property, sidewalks and parking lots are kept clean on a weekly scheduled basis.
- Monthly routine maintenance and checks were performed on all Borough vehicles.
- Monthly routine inspections on all parking lots were performed around the Borough.
- Monthly vehicle issues were handled as they arose.
- Borough vehicles' state inspections and general maintenance have been completed.
- Trash and litter are picked up on a daily basis.
